

### **2014-15 Accomplishments & New Initiatives**

#### **The South Asian Community Outreach Project**

The South Asian Community Outreach Project is a three year, Trillium Funded Project that aims to educate and improve access to care within the South Asian Community, with Bethell Hospice, Heart House Hospice and Punjabi Community Health Services collectively delivering the programming. This year, Bethell Hospice organized the first-ever South Asian Community Education Forum, bringing together service agencies in Dufferin & Peel Region to learn about delivering quality care to the South Asian community at end of life.



The forum was a great success with close to 200 attendees. Parliamentary Assistant to the Minister of Health, John Fraser, opened the Forum with a message of Ontario's commitment to Hospice Palliative Care.

### **Psychosocial Spiritual Care Program**

In 2014-15, Bethell Hospice successfully secured funding to hire two Psychosocial Spiritual Care Coordinators who will provide care at Bethell Hospice, as well as three other hospices within the Central West LHIN: Heart House Hospice, Hospice Dufferin and Hospice Vaughan. This much-needed service will assist us in our mandate to deliver holistic care to our clients.

### Wellness, Pain & Symptom Management Clinic

The Wellness, Pain and Symptom Management Clinic is run by Bethell Hospice out of the Caledon Specialist Clinic, with Medical Director, Dr Michael Gagnon, providing medical consultation. The weekly clinic provides those in the community living with a life-limiting illness a place to speak with a medical professional, to connect with others in a similar situation and to offer brief reprieve for their caregivers.

#### **Seniors Educating Seniors**

Bethell Hospice's *Seniors Educating Seniors* project received \$25,000 in funding from the New Horizons for Seniors program. This federally-funded program aims to enhance quality of life for seniors who wish to volunteer, providing opportunities for inclusion and shared learning experiences. *Seniors Educating Seniors* exceeded expectations, recruiting fifty-three new volunteers for Bethell Hospice.





## **Resident Care Program**

- Bethell House was home to 138 residents during the 2014-15 year
- Average occupancy 85%
- Average Length of Stay 25 days
- 73% of those served were 65+
- 88% of those served had a diagnosis of cancer

## **Community Services**

In 2014-15, we continued our commitment to strengthen Community Services. More bereavement groups were offered, our Client Coordinator saw more individuals and new initiatives were launched. Community clients made connections with others in similar situations and received necessary supports.

- 391 clients were served in our Community Services Program
- Bereavement Groups were offered in Caledon, Bolton & Brampton
- Funding was secured for the Psychosocial Spiritual Care Program
- The Wellness, Pain & Symptom Management Clinic opened


