### **About Bethell Hospice**

Located just minutes north of Brampton in the quiet village of Inglewood, Bethell Hospice provides personalized hospice palliative care, as well as comfort and support for family dealing with loss. Hospice services are an essential component of our health care system, focussing on individualized care and comfort. Our professional medical team provides pain and symptom management, comfort and care, all in a beautiful, tranquil environment.

Each of our ten private resident rooms features wide doors that open directly to our beautiful gardens.

Each room also features a comfortable pullout couch for overnight guests. We encourage you to treat Bethell Hospice as your home, and to utilize the lovely glass sunrooms, library, living and dining rooms, and children's playroom. Family and friends, including children and pets, are encouraged to visit often.

Our professional team of Physicians, Registered Nurses, Registered Practical Nurses and Personal Support Workers specialize in palliative care. Nursing care is provided 24 hours a day. Support is also available to our residents and their families from our Social Workers and Psychosocial Spiritual Care Coordinators. Trained hospice volunteers are on hand to prepare customized resident meals, offer a variety of holistic services, and provide warm smiles and comfort.

### **Booking a Tour & Becoming a Resident**

To be eligible for admittance to Bethell Hospice, prospective residents must have a life-limiting illness with a life expectancy of less than three months, a valid Ontario health card, a designated Power of Attorney for Personal Care (POA) or a Substitute Decision Maker (SDM), and a completed Do Not Resuscitate form (DNR). A medical referral must be provided to Bethell Hospice by a physician, a hospital, or the local health agency.



There is often a wait list for admission to Bethell Hospice. Admission decisions are always based on the priority needs of each person, rather than on the length of time on the wait list.

As part of your advance care planning, we encourage you and your family to visit Bethell Hospice well in advance of a possible admission. We welcome you to book a tour of our residence, talk with our staff and volunteers, and ask any questions you may have.
