Therapeutic Touch is a program generally provided in person involving gentle touch. However, research shows recipients still benefit from the program even when they are physically distanced from the practitioner.

Trained volunteers facilitate these sessions. Sessions of Distant Therapeutic Touch can induce relaxation, reduce physical and emotional pain, and increase an overall sense of well-being. Sessions typically last for up to 30 minutes. This program is available both for residential and community clients.
