Trained volunteers are available to provide companionship and support via phone or video calls to clients in the community. Living with illness, caring for someone who is ill, and grieving the death of a loved one can all be lonely and isolating experiences.

With social distancing in effect, these feelings can be even more intense. Weekly connection with a volunteer, who can check in and chat, can be a valuable coping tool, providing an opportunity to debrief thoughts and feelings about your experiences, as well as the social benefit of connecting with others.
