

Bethell Hospice Foundation exists to raise funds to ensure the ongoing operation of Bethell Hospice in our community. Unlike many other local charities, Bethell Hospice depends on the generosity of donors simply to remain in operation.

All residence services and programs are provided at no cost and there are no fees to participate in community programs.

Government funding through the Ontario Ministry of Health covers only direct care medical staffing costs at Bethell Hospice. Every other cost is funded directly from donations.

To keep the doors of Bethell Hospice open and all programs and services available at no cost to residents, community clients and their families, Bethell Hospice Foundation must raise over \$1,500,000 each year.

Every gift makes a meaningful difference that directly impacts many lives.

Bethell Hospice, located in the quiet village of Inglewood, provides personalized hospice palliative care to enhance the care at end of life for individuals facing a life-limiting illness, as well as comfort and support for families dealing with loss.



Dignity and comfort are the cornerstones of care at Bethell Hospice. We welcome people of all backgrounds, cultures and religions.

Each of our ten private resident rooms feature wide doors that open directly to our beautiful gardens.

Hospice services are an essential component of our health care system, focusing on individualized care and comfort. Our professional care team provides pain and symptom management, comfort, and 24 hour a day nursing care. Support is also available to our residents and their families through our Social Work and Psychosocial Spiritual Care teams.



Trained hospice volunteers are also available to provide a variety of holistic services, such as Therapeutic Touch, as well as offer companionship through our in-home volunteer visiting program.
